Good morning. Today is the 141st day of the year. On this day in 1901, both branches of the “Municipal Assembly” (the city legislative body of that time) approved a subway tunnel under Flatbush Avenue, part of today’s Q and B route. The vote was almost unanimous, since both parties had instructed their officials to vote for the tunnel. One alderman, however, said that the Long Island Rail Road should pay part of the cost, presumably because many of the passengers on the tunnel route would transfer to and from the railroad.

Lopez Faces Tough, Uphill Race for City Council Seat

Vito Lopez, the Brooklyn assemblyman accused of asking young female staffers to massage him, touch his cancerous tumors and join him in hotel rooms, resigned on Monday from the Legislature amid sexual harassment allegations.

Lopez said many times that he was resigning not because of the charges, but to run for the City Council in the 34th District in Williamsburg and Bushwick, his historic power base. But a cursory glance at the race shows that Lopez has an uphill battle, to put it mildly.

Lopez’ main opponent is Antonio Reynoso, chief of staff for Councilwoman Diana Reyna (cur-

rently on leave). He has a professional-looking website featuring a high-powered list of endorsements, some of which include the United Federation of Teachers, Local 1199 SEIU, the Working Families Party, and three Democratic mayoral hopefuls – Christine Quinn, Bill de Blasio and John Liu.

Campaign Finance Board records reveal that he had raised, as of Monday, \$86,764. Contributors ranged from retirees and postal and cafeteria workers to attorneys and executives of such powerful local organizations as El Puente, Heart-Share Human Services and St. Nicholas Alliance. One noticed contributions from several current City Council members, such as Daniel

Lawsuit Challenges Anti-Theft Tactics

A lawsuit in Brooklyn is challenging the New York Police Department’s practice of leaving wallets, cash and bags in plain sight to tempt thieves.

Lawyers who filed the lawsuit Monday in Brooklyn federal court say they’ll seek class-action status. They say they want to represent innocent individuals swept up in a tactic meant to entice thieves. The police department places the items in high-theft areas, hoping to attract the attention of thieves interested in cash or cell phones. Police have used the tactic on subway platforms, park benches and in cars.

The lawsuit seeks to stop the police tactic and have it declared in conflict with existing law.

Willowtown Fair: Heights’ Easygoing Get-together

The 2013 Willowtown Spring Fair brought neighbors together on Saturday for a mellow day of music, food, sack races, tug-of-war and an architectural walking tour.

A boat with eight oars docked in the middle of Willow Street drew attention to a “boating adventure” raffle prize, and the old-fashioned jazz of Mona’s Hot Four had people dancing in the street. Iris Cafe and Waterfront Wine and Spirits provided food and drinks, and volunteers from Mickel’s Garden, led by Melissa Neel, sold plants to fund a new greenhouse and other garden improvements.

The annual event raises money for the Willowtown Association’s

community projects, such as tree planting and upkeep, but it’s also a celebration of the continuing existence of the historic enclave at the southwestern edge of Brooklyn Heights.

A self-guided tour pointed out architectural gems — a number saved, by the efforts of the Willowtown Association and the Brooklyn Heights Association, from Robert Moses’ wrecking ball in the 1950s.

Many of the houses in Willowtown date from the 1840s, including four sharing a continuous portico of tall wooden columns at the southern end of Willow Place, and four clapboard frame and brick houses in “Cottage Row” at

Brooklyn City Council Races Blow Hot and Cold

Whether 2013’s City Council races will offer Brooklynites a meaningful decision depends on where they live, with some districts set to offer a menu of choices and some very few.

According to filings with the New York State Board of Elections and the city’s Campaign Finance Board, five Brooklyn council districts boast five or more candidates to date. One is the 47th District, encompassing Coney Island, Gravesend, Benson-

hurst and Brighton Beach, where term limits will force Domenic Recchia to vacate his seat.

So far, Todd Dobrin, Brian Gotlieb, John Lisysanskiy, Michael Treybich and Mark Treyger have hats in the ring. Some have raised a lot more money than others, and some of them may not make the ballot, but for now, they’re in.

Contrast that with the 39th district, where incumbent Brad Lander is the only candidate registered with campaign finance so far, having raised more than

Bestselling ‘Coolidge’ Author Amity Shlaes Comes Home to Brooklyn Heights for Book Talk

Amity Shlaes, the best-selling author and sage – though without the grey beard – of the world where politics, policy and economics collide, will speak in person on May 22 to her friends and neighbors at the Heights Casino in Brooklyn Heights.

She’s been on the national book-tour circuit plugging her latest bestseller, “Coolidge,” telling the story of a president she greatly admires because, put simply, “He cut the budget.”

Back home in the Heights, where “liberals” strut but conservatives quietly flourish, she will share the wealth of her ideas, passion and copious research about a period of American history that helped her produce two of her three bestsellers in recent years.

“Coolidge” – which spent seven weeks on the *New York Times* bestseller list after its February publication – is a riveting read about America’s 30th President, who Shlaes says has been wrongly blamed for precipitating the Great Depression.

“Coolidge is like Brooklyn. People who don’t know him under-rate him – and he liked it that way,” the Yale grad said in a recent sit-down with the *Brooklyn Daily Eagle*.

“He under-promised and over-delivered habitually,” she said.

The famously taciturn Republican – who performed the rare feat of cutting both the federal budget and taxes in the face of political pressure from the Progress-

sive Party and cash-strapped farmers and military veterans – was a fan of New York City.

“He made a speech about New York and why it was important the U.S. had two capitals, Washington and New York, and not just one – so that commerce could be in one place and government could be somewhere else. And New York was a check on Washington,” she said.

“And I’m sure he would have said Brooklyn was a check on New York.”

Her talk at the Heights Casino about her biography of the 1920s president will be her second for its Speakers’ Series. She spoke previously about her 2007 book “The Forgotten Man: A New History of the Great Depression,” which sold 300,000 copies.

Her third bestseller, “The Greedy Hand: How Taxes Drive Americans Crazy and What to Do About It,” was published in 1999.

“What we like about the Heights community is they’re so loyal,” said Shlaes, who worked for 17 years at the *Wall Street Journal* as reporter, copy editor, Op Ed editor and editorial board member. “We appreciate their loyalty.”

She moved to the neighborhood with her family in 1991 from a *Journal* posting in Brussels, in part because numerous colleagues called the neighborhood home.

Among them was the late Robert Bartley, who presided over the *Journal’s* editorial page for three decades and was awarded a Pulitzer Prize and the Presidential Medal of Freedom.

Shlaes – who co-authored a piece about tax philosophy with Bartley in a Manhattan Institute retrospective, “Turning Intellect into Influence” – thinks Coolidge bore an uncanny resemblance to him.

“He was the pre-incarnation of Mr. Bartley,” she said.

Bartley had sandy hair like the 30th president, and “a farmerish squint and a cackle,” she said. “Coolidge also cackled, I am told,” she added.

Warren Phillips, who was the publisher of the *Journal* and CEO of parent company Dow Jones, also lived in the Heights.

She and husband Seth Lipsky, who’s the founder and editor of the revived *New York Sun* and the English edition of the *Forward*, wouldn’t dream of living elsewhere now.

“The pedestrian aspect is one of the great attractions, the carlessness of it and the serendipity of having no car and running into people,” she said, “instead of jousting with them or competing with them in an automobile for a parking space.”

The self-described “dog person” takes neighborhood walks with her two yellow Labs, whose names reflect her fascination with Depression-era politics. Frannie is named for FDR’s Labor Secretary Frances Perkins; Rex is short for Rexford Tugwell, FDR’s brainy economist, whom Shlaes called “the Rahm Emanuel of the New Deal – he says the truth no one else dares say.”

A “Coolidge revival” is afoot with Shlaes leading the way – and detractors are suggesting “Silent Cal,” the Vermont farmer’s son, is unworthy of the surge of enthusiasm.

He had his faults – he supported tariffs and was “kind of naïve on Europe” – but brought Ameri-

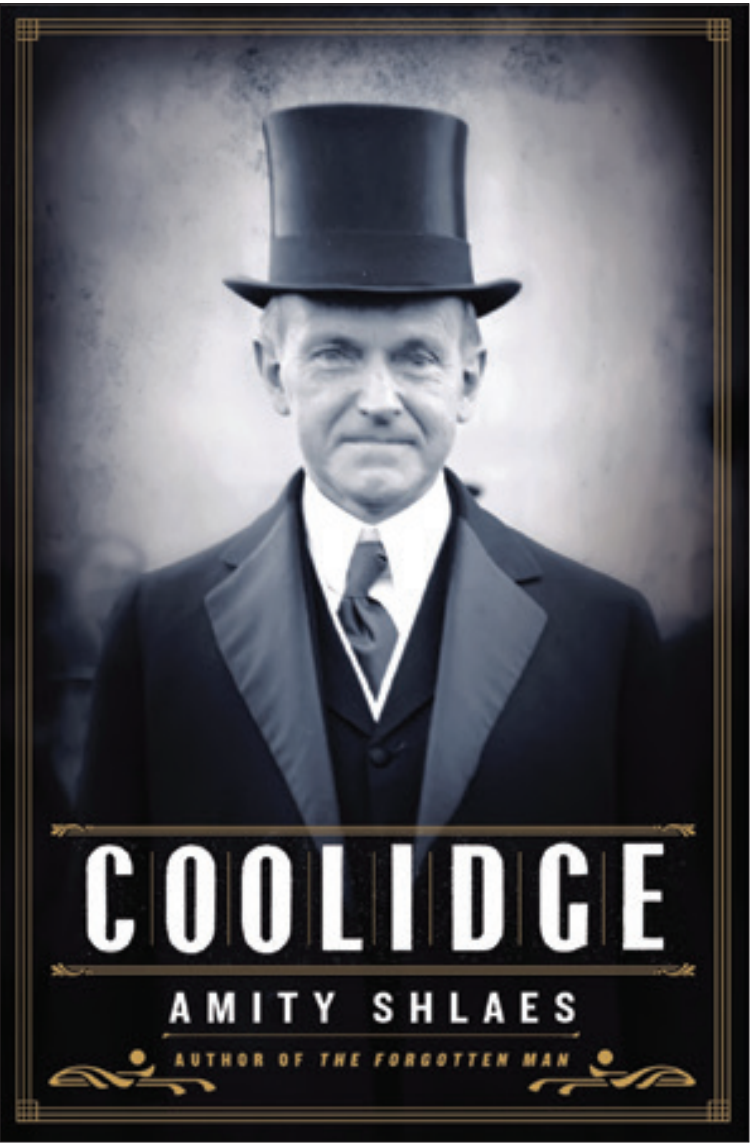
er taxes – Coolidge cut taxes lower than Reagan but he always balanced the budget.

“So this is hard to argue against,” she said.

“When someone has a weak argument, the giveaway is that they go ‘ad hominem,’” she added. “They start talking about what you look like or how you smell when they don’t have a substantive argument. And that’s often what happens with Coolidge detractors.”

The syndicated columnist was picked last year by investment guru James Glassman, who runs the George W. Bush Institute in Dallas, to be director of an initiative called The 4% Growth Project. Her duties include running a debate program about economic issues for high-school students.

She’s also busy completing a graphic novel version of “The Forgotten Man” with illustrator Paul Rivoche for 2014 publication, writing a new book whose subject matter she’s not ready to reveal yet and teaching econom-

ca solid prosperity, Shlaes argued.

“There was 4% growth when he was president and unemployment below 5%. Wages rose in real terms, patents proliferated and people got indoor plumbing,” she said.

“It was fabulous for the middle class. They got the Model T and the Model A. Saturday became a concept in the ’20s; it was a work day before that. And we got low-

ics at New York University’s Stern School of Business MBA program.

Elected officials today don’t feel the urgency to cut the federal budget like Coolidge did.

Because interest rates are low, “we don’t think we have any crisis,” Shlaes said.

“If interest rates go up like they did in the ’70s, then politicians from both parties will begin to talk,” she predicted.

Garodnick. Steve Hindy, head of the Brooklyn Brewery, is also listed as a contributor.

On the other hand, a “Lopez for City Council” site was not visible on the internet yesterday. Lopez had raised \$38,393 as of Monday. Among his supporters were retirees, several attorneys, a manager at Giando’s in Williamsburg, an official at Bushwick United Head Start

and his longtime girlfriend, Angela Battaglia. The biggest contribution, \$2,500, was from Lopez himself.

In a single, terse sentence, Lopez on Monday announced the resignation from the seat he’s held since 1984: “I hereby resign the public office of Member of the Assembly from the 53rd Assembly District, Kings County, effective 9 a.m. Monday, May 20, 2013.”

Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver announced Lopez’s reversal. The powerful speaker had planned Monday to begin a rare and uncertain effort to expel a sitting lawmaker. Expelling Lopez could have proved difficult — he’s not charged with any crime and was overwhelmingly re-elected in November, when the scandal was already widely known.

increasing rail traffic.

The tunnel was not completed until 1918-1920, since so many subway projects were under way at the time.

Well-known people who were born today include actress Lisa Edelstein (“House”), U.S. Senator and comedian Al Franken (D-Minn.), singer-songwriter Leo Sayer, baseball manager Bobby Cox and actor Lawrence “Mister T” Tureaud (“The A Team.”)

But Lopez and Silver have been under increased pressure since last week, when reports from Special Prosecutor Daniel Donovan and the state Joint Commission on Public Ethics detailed allegations involving four female staffers. The allegations including Lopez forcing his hand up a woman’s leg, trying to coerce them to share hotel rooms with him, touching the tumors on his neck and requiring them to write flattering and flirtatious memos to him that he later tried to use to discredit their accusations.

The allegations involving two women came last summer, when the scandal first became public. That’s when Silver and top Assembly staffers, along with reviews by top staffers for Attorney General Eric Schneiderman and Comptroller Thomas DiNapoli, authorized a secret \$103,000 settlement for Lopez’s first accusers.

Political science Professor Doug Muzzio of Baruch College called the resignation “partial deodorizing” of scandal-plagued Albany.

“Albany needs more extensive and permanent disinfectant,” he said Saturday.

“It’s a good thing for the state, the Assembly and the people of

Brooklyn that he resigned,” said Richard Brodsky of the Wagner School of New York University, who also served with Lopez and Silver in the Assembly.

“In the heat of the moment, it is also important to recognize that there ought to be limitations on a legislative body removing merely the unpleasant or the disgusting from membership,” Brodsky said, noting the expulsion effort wasn’t a sure thing. “The law at stake here is the right of the people to be represented. On balance, in this case, this resignation is important and necessary.”

He noted the case after World War I when the Assembly refused to seat three socialists elected to office.

“Today we look at that as it was, the Red Scare,” said Jack McEneny, a former Democratic assemblyman who acted as a historian for the chamber who agrees there was a legal question to expelling Lopez. “Today, in our minds, that’s not appropriate for a democracy.”

Lopez has denied sexually harassing anyone. He noted the two investigations found he committed no crime and that only the voters should decide if he leaves office. His attorney didn’t respond to a request for comment Saturday.

the northern end of Columbia Place. The A.T. White Community Center on Willow Place dates from 1867.

Willowtown also boasts “the world’s only Greek Revival subway ventilator” at 58 Joralemon Street and the former Metropolitan Transportation Authority substation at 21 Willow Place.

Today the Willowtown Association, with a 12-member board under President Ben Bankson, remains active in community affairs. As a member of the

Brooklyn Bridge Park Coalition, the group works to mitigate the park’s potential negative impact on Willowtown’s traffic, noise and views.

The board endorsed renaming the Palmetto Playground the Adam Yauch Playground; convinced the MTA to repair the roadbed for the subway under Joralemon Street, and fought the Riverside apartment’s move to replace the building’s historic garden with a parking garage.

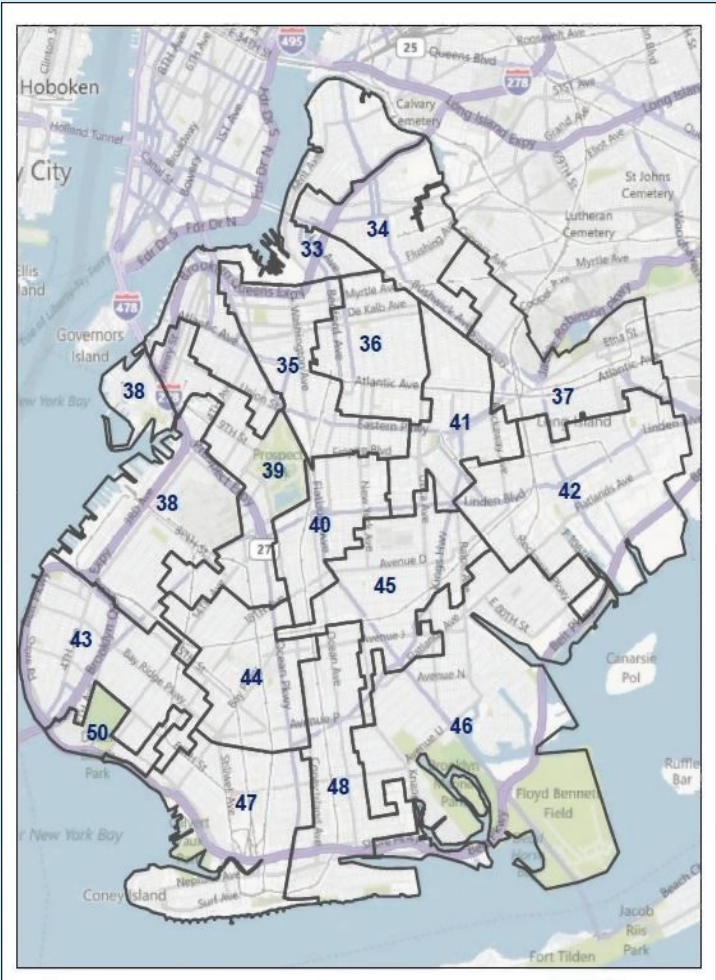
\$103,000. Or the 44th, where David Greenfield is the only candidate registered with CFB to date, posting \$124,000 in contributions. There’s a Republican registered with the state BOE in Greenfield’s district, and both a Republican and a Green candidate in Lander’s, but none of them have reported any activity this year.

Of the 18 Council members affected by term limits, seven are in Brooklyn. Brooklyn’s Letitia James doesn’t have to vacate her seat but is running for public advocate instead.

About \$2 million has been raised, and \$800,000 spent, by Brooklyn Council candidates so far, leaving \$1.2 million or so in candidates’ coffers. So far, the 47th district race has brought in the most money, some \$274,000. Incumbent Vincent Gentile is the top fundraiser to date, with \$140,000 hauled in. Antonio Reynoso, one of the candidates running to replace Diana Reyna in her Williamsbridge/Bushwick district (that’s the seat Vito Lopez is vying for), has the most cash on hand: \$85,000.

There are 16 council districts in Brooklyn. In 2009, seven incumbent Brooklyn council members faced primaries; only Kendall Stewart lost. In the general election, three Brooklyn council members—Mathieu Eugene, Michael Nelson and Domenic Recchia—faced no major-party opposition but did have third-party opponents, whom they bested.

One, Simcha Felder, faced

only himself; he was cross-endorsed by the Democrats, Republicans and Conservatives.

If You're Not Part Of the Problem.....

The recent wave of indictments of elected officials seems to encompass everybody. Democrats and Republicans (although not the Brooklyn Republicans, at least so far), and members of all ethnic groups have been named indicted or are the subjects of investigation.

Vito Lopez, who recently said he would resign from his seat in the state Assembly and who by all accounts acted like a "Little Caesar" in his district, is only the most extreme example. More typical is the low-key politician who takes bribes in exchange for pushing a new housing development or other "perk."

Of course, this is nothing new. For many decades, Tammany Hall ruled in Manhattan and many other parts of the city. Like the old mob, Tammany's way of operating was "I do you a favor, you do me a favor." There's nothing wrong with this per se, unless that "favor" happens to be illegal.

In fact, one 19th century state legislator, George Washington Plunkitt, drew a line between "dishonest graft," or graft that lines the pockets of one person exclusively for his own personal gain; and "honest graft," in which the spoils go into the coffers of the party, campaign workers and others who are on the ballot for the same party.

Graft didn't extend only to the legislature. In one highly suspicious episode, during the early 1940s, Abe Reles, a government witness in a mob case, supposedly leaped to his death from the Half Moon Hotel in Coney Island, where he was being held by police. Incredibly, all of the police officers who were assigned to guard him testified that they were asleep when Reles supposedly tried to escape. I personally find Lucky Luciano's account of the incident – that the mob paid off these particular cops – more believable.

Until recently, many New Yorkers were led to believe that these types of shenanigans had come to an end with the rise of Reform-minded Mayor Fiorello LaGuardia in the 1930s and the fall of Carmine de Sapio, the last Tammany Hall boss, in the early 1960s. What happened?

In Brooklyn, part of the problem might have been that the Reform Democratic movement was never as strong here as it was in Manhattan. While in Manhattan, the Reform Democrats had more or less supplanted the Regular Democrats by the end of the 1960s, in Brooklyn, we still had figures like Meade Esposito and Mel Miller into the 1970s and '80s. Reformers were strong in Carroll Gardens, Park Slope and similar areas, but in places like Canarsie and Midwood, Bed-Stuy and Brighton Beach, the Reform movement was weak indeed.

How do we get out of this mess? What happens to the politicians who have been investigated or have been forced to resign is a matter for the legal system to decide. But if you want good government, what I would say is to paraphrase the well-known 1960s saying attributed to Eldridge Cleaver: "If you're not part of the solution, you're part of the problem."

If you decry corrupt politicians, but aren't registered to vote, saying, "They're all thieves anyway," then you're part of the problem! If more people decided to be part of the solution – volunteering in political campaigns, going to community board meetings, joining political clubs, volunteering to be on the county committee – then those "rotten apples" would have less of an opportunity to dominate the process because they would be far outnumbered. If you want to do away with corruption, it's not enough to walk the walk; you have to talk the talk. Volunteer for your local organization today!

‘Mapping Manhattan’ Author to Celebrate Book Launch in Brooklyn

Armed with hundreds of blank maps that had been painstakingly printed by hand, Becky Cooper walked Manhattan from end to end, asking strangers to map their city and mail in the results. Soon, her P.O. box was filled with an atlas of intimate narratives: past loves, childhood memories, and surprising confessions. Some well-known New Yorkers then joined the project, including Yoko Ono, Momofuku chef David Chang, Tony-award winner Harvey Fierstein, and tight-rope walker Philippe Petit, as well as the New Yorkers behind New York—the head of the Public Library’s map division, a former police lieutenant who responded to the call on 9/11, and many more.

Cooper’s project turned into a book titled “Mapping Manhattan: A Love (and Sometimes Hate) Story in Maps by 75 New Yorkers” (Abrams Image; April 2013), and the author will celebrate the book’s release on Thursday, June 6, at BookCourt in Cobble Hill. With a forward by *New Yorker* staff writer Adam Gopnik, “Mapping Manhattan” comprises 75 extraordinary maps created by New Yorkers both anonymous and notable. The maps are organized roughly geographically from 228th Street to Battery Park, mostly thematically, and always visually. Interspersed throughout the

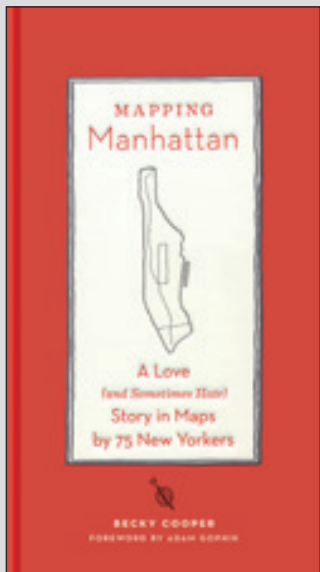
pages are sketches of everyday New York scenes and anecdotes from the characters Cooper encountered along the way. Together, they form a portrait of Manhattan that vibrantly illustrates that in a city of 8 million people, there are 8 million stories, and 8 million New Yorkers.

A book with no true end, “Mapping Manhattan” features a blank map that invites readers to share their Manhattan and partake in this unconventional public art project.

The June 6 event will begin at 7 p.m. BookCourt is located at 163 Court St. in Cobble Hill.

Memorial Day is for More Than Just Shopping, Marine Says

The upcoming Memorial Day holiday should be about more than just barbecues, shopping excursions and trips to the beach, according to a U.S. Marine, who said he’s concerned Americans have forgotten the real meaning of the day.

“It’s more of a commercial day. It has lost its meaning,” Lt. Col. Richard Bordonaro told a roomful of military veterans at a breakfast event in Bay Ridge on May 16. “What we’ve lost is reflection of what the holiday is about,” he said. Many Americans don’t take the time to think about the holiday’s purpose – to honor those who have died in America’s wars – he said.

Bordonaro, an inspector-instructor with the Marine Corps 6th Communications Battalion, was one of two military men receiving awards from state Sen. Marty Golden (R-C-Bay Ridge-southern Brooklyn) at the lawmaker’s annual Memorial Day Breakfast at the Bay Ridge Manor Thursday morning. Golden traditionally holds the breakfast a few weeks before Memorial Day. Howard Dunn, a World War II Navy veteran, was honored along with Bordonaro.

Bordonaro, who said his unit will march in the Brooklyn Memorial Day Parade on May 27, urged civilians to “take time to reflect on the men and women who paid the last full measure” and to “remember the sacrifices these men and women have made.”

The breakfast drew hundreds of veterans, including men and women who fought in every conflict from World War II to the war in Afghanistan. Members of American Legion and VFW posts, as well as Catholic war veterans and Jewish war veterans groups, show up with large contingents every year to enjoy a free breakfast of scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, French toast, and potatoes and to listen as Golden praises them for their service to the country.

“Everyone in this room deserves our thanks and appreciation,” Golden said. “We are the greatest nation on earth. What’s most important is to teach our young people why. We are a great nation because we have the best military in the world,” he said.

Golden presented citations to Bordonaro and Dunn, explaining that the two men would also be receiving State Senate proclamations within a few days. Bordonaro was honored for his efforts to assist Hurricane Sandy victims in the Rockways and for his participation every year in the Firefighter Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers Run, Golden said. The run is held every year in memory of firefighter Stephen Siller who was killed in the Sept. 11 terror attack at the World Trade Center.

Dunn, a member of the Amity Post of the American Legion, was singled out for his work with the Wounded Warrior Project, an effort to help military men and women who have lost limbs in battle. Dunn has visited injured soldiers at Walter Reed Army Medical Center and has raised more than \$28,000 for veteran’s causes, Golden said. “It’s guys like Howie who give them a real boost,” Golden said. Dunn is also famous in Bay Ridge for his effort to plant American flags on sidewalks in front of stores. Golden also noted that Dunn, a cancer survivor, has been active in the Boy Scouts of America since 1939.

In his remarks, Dunn paid tribute to the Wounded Warriors. “They deserve every help we all can give them. Please support the Wounded Warriors as much as you can,” he said.

The event included the playing of “Taps” in memory of those killed in America’s wars.

Brooklyn's Prince to Miss a Few Weeks to Play for Russia

Epiphanny Prince is headed to Russia.

The Brooklyn native will miss a few weeks of the WNBA season to join the Russian national women's basketball team for the EuroBasket tournament from June 15-30. Prince will leave the Chicago Sky on June 4 to train with the Russian team for a week before the tournament begins. She'll be back with the Sky at the end of the month and most likely miss six games.

"I want to play the whole WNBA season, but made a commitment to play for the Russian national team," Prince told The Associated Press in a phone interview.

The top five finishers in the EuroBasket, which will be played in France, will qualify for next year's world championship in Turkey. The U.S. already qualified by winning the 2012 London Olympics.

"It's going to be tough on us, but we knew it was part of her deal going in and we'll deal with that," Chicago Sky general manager and coach Pokey Chatman said.

Prince has a chance to be the second American-born player to play for Russia's national team in the Olympics. Becky Hammon played in the last two Olympics for Russia and also the 2010 world championship. Prince became a naturalized citizen in 2010, but this

will be her first time playing with the national team.

"I didn't really think about playing in the Olympics as a kid growing up," Prince said. "I did watch NBA and WNBA games but never really dreamed about the Olympics."

Since Prince hasn't played for the United States in any major FI-

BA-sanctioned international events, she is allowed to compete for Russia.

"It was the main thrust for Prince getting a Russian passport," Chatman said. "The Russians lack a true point guards. Even though it's not her natural position she can be serviceable at point. She's a prolific scorer and is someone who can run the point for them."

Russia is coming off a disappointing Olympics where they finished fourth losing to Australia in the bronze medal game. The Russians had won bronze medals at the previous two Olympics, but haven't won a gold medal since 1992 when the country was known as the Unified Team. The Russians just hired Prince's winter club coach, Alfredas Vainauskas, to lead the national team for the next four years.

"I know the coach and his system so that helps," Prince said. "I'm not really sure which players are going to be on the team."

Prince said she's still learning the language despite playing the

past few winters in Russia. She's confident that won't be an issue since most of her new teammates speak English.

Prince burst onto the nation-

al spotlight in high school when she scored a record 113 points in a game. She then went on to star at Rutgers for Hall of Fame coach C. Vivian Stringer before leaving college after her junior year to play professionally overseas — a rare move in women's basketball. The 25-year-old had a stellar season last year for the Sky averaging 22 points before fracturing her right foot in June. She came back but couldn't get Chicago into the WNBA playoffs for the first time ever.

Prince hopes to change those fortunes this year.

"That's what I'm hoping for," she said. "We have a really good group."

The Sky have faith in their young star, signing her to a multi-year contract extension Wednesday.

She's a franchise type player you want to build around," Chatman said.

Prince was excited that she'll be in Chicago for a while.

"I would like to finish my career here," she said. "I'm excited that I was able to get it done."

NY-Area College Baseball Star Looks for Shot a Year After Streak

Taylor Sewitt was the talk of college baseball a year ago, a rubber-armed right-hander who threw one shutout inning after another.

His deceptive submarine-style delivery helped Sewitt rack up 22 scoreless innings for Manhattan College in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference last May, winning three games in as many days and tossing an eye-popping 296 pitches.

And, that included 11 shutout innings of relief in the title game against Canisius.

"Man, that was crazy," Sewitt said in a telephone interview. "And a lot of fun."

His extraordinary performance made national headlines as the Jaspers advanced to the NCAA tournament, where he threw five more shutout innings in a loss to top-ranked South Carolina. With all the attention, Sewitt was as close to a celebrity as a college pitcher could be. What a way to cap his senior season, and he figured it could only get better with the major league draft a few days later.

But 1,238 players were taken over three days and 40 rounds last June — and Sewitt wasn't among them. Surely he'd hear from a major league team to join them as an undrafted free agent, he thought.

That was a call that never came. "It was like going from the biggest high to the biggest low," Sewitt said. "It was hard mentally to deal with that."

Nearly a year later, Sewitt is back on the mound — still with those big league dreams — pitching in Indiana for the Gary SouthShore

RailCats of the independent American Association.

"The thing for me is that this is my biggest goal in life, to play professional baseball in the major leagues," he said. "It's one of those things where it's like, 'I know I belong there, I know I can pitch there.' I just need a shot. I'll make it there one day."

"It's just going to be a slightly different path."

And one that several ballplayers needing a break have taken to get to the majors, including Kevin Millar, George Sherrill, Kerry Ligtenberg, Brad Ziegler, Daniel Nava and Steve Delabar.

Gary opened its season Thursday night, and Sewitt has already pitched three times in relief, allowing two hits and one unearned run with four strikeouts and no walks in 4 2-3 innings.

"For me, the most important thing is to pitch well and get picked up as fast as I can," the 23-year-old Sewitt said. "As much as I'll always have a place for this team because they're the only team that's given me a chance, I want to be in the major leagues and my goal is to get there as soon as I can. I want to help this team out while I'm helping myself out."

Long-time RailCats manager Greg Tagert is used to players hoping their stay with his team is short.

"Believe me, one of the things we tell all of our players is that I don't know if I'd want a player who didn't want to be in the big leagues because then you'd wonder what their motivation is," Tagert said. "He'll get an opportunity to compete against experienced players and showcase his abilities. That's the most a guy can ask for."

Sewitt, from Highland Mills, N.Y., wasn't sure that chance would ever come. Shortly after the draft last year, the RailCats contacted him to see if he'd be interested, but he passed because he wanted to rest his tired arm.

But the weeks turned into months, and no one else showed any interest.

"I thought it was over," he said. "I didn't want to go out there to Gary and pitch bad, though, and then they probably wouldn't ever look at me again."

There were also a few strikes against the 6-foot-2, 195-pound Sewitt, including the fact that he was new to pitching as a converted shortstop who had thrown just 30 innings in his first three seasons at Manhattan. He was a relative unknown because of that, despite a terrific final year in which he ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders by going 11-2 with a 2.63 ERA. He also had that funky delivery, something Sewitt picked up during his junior season at the suggestion of one of the Jaspers' assistants.

Sewitt also wasn't the prototypical over-the-top flamethrower, but his sidwinding style also puts less strain on his arm and potentially gives his career some longevity.

"When a guy does something different, a major league club has to be absolutely sure of him in the draft," said Tagert, who was made aware of Sewitt by Manhattan pitching coach Elvys Quezada. "That's why our league is great in that it gives somebody like Taylor a chance at a high level where major league organizations can use it as a barometer."

Sewitt was watching the New York Yankees and Baltimore Orioles play in the American League Division Series last October when the RailCats came calling again.

"Here was a guy who we kept looking at those numbers," Tagert said, "and you just couldn't ignore them, the things he was doing."

This time, Sewitt accepted the opportunity and was eager to get his career on track with the RailCats.

"Once he committed to us, Taylor was gung-ho," Tagert said. "I heard from him every couple of weeks."

So, Sewitt will try to prove himself against the likes of the Lincoln Saltdogs, Sioux City Explorers and the Wichita Wingnuts — teams he had never heard of until a few months ago.

Sewitt says his arm feels better than it ever has, and he has really perfected throwing submarine after "almost faking it the whole way" last season. He also credits Quezada, a one-time pitching prospect of both the Yankees and Mets, for teaching him about the mental approach to pitching — something else he tried to hone while waiting for his next call to the mound.

"Switching to submarine definitely made this possible for him because it gave him something special," Quezada said. "When you're scouting, you look for guys who stand out, and that switch made him stand out. It breeds confidence, once you get that ball rolling. You feel invincible almost, and that's exactly where Taylor got to."

"It's a pretty good story, and I'm really pulling for the kid."

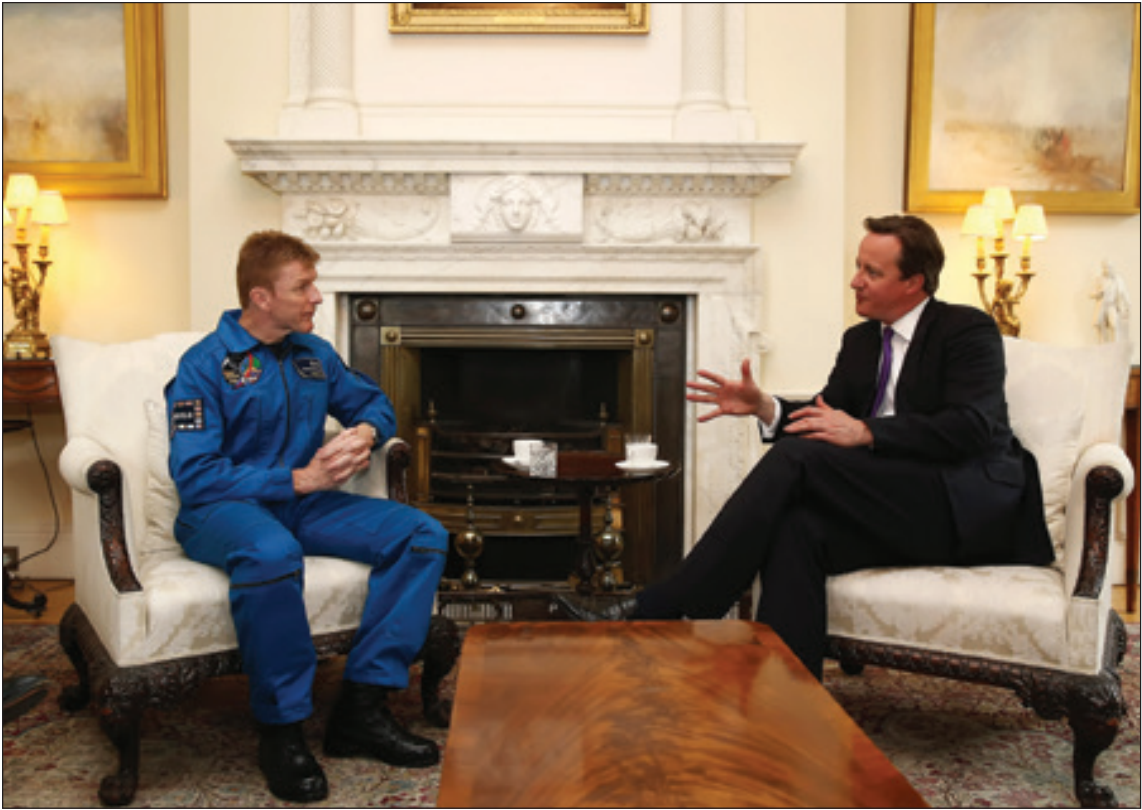

Smoking Terror: Busted Smuggling Ring Charged with Sending Cash to Killers

A smuggling ring that made a fortune selling more than a million cartons of untaxed cigarettes in New York may have funneled some of the illicit proceeds to terrorist groups, authorities said Thursday.

The traffickers lived modestly and had alleged links to known terrorists, including Omar Abdel-Rah-

man, the blind cleric serving a life sentence for a conspiracy to blow up New York City landmarks. That combination has raised concerns about where the money went.

"We know they made tens of millions of dollars but so far we've only found a fraction of that," state Attorney General Eric T. Schneiderman said while announcing enterprise corruption and other charges against 16 people, all Palestinian immigrants.

Two reputed ringleaders, brothers Basel and Samir Ramadan, were arrested Wednesday in Maryland. Investigators found \$1.5 million — some stashed in black plastic garbage bags — in the home and car of Basel Ramadan, authorities said.

Arrests also were made in New York City, New Jersey and Delaware.

A yearlong investigation found that the Ramadans and other suspects formed a distribution chain that began with the purchase of mass quantities of cigarettes from a Virginia wholesaler, authorities said. The cigarettes were hidden in a public storage facility in Delaware, where distributors picked up about 20,000 cartons a week for sale at markets throughout New York City and at grocery stores in upstate New York, authorities said.

Schneiderman and city Police Commissioner Raymond Kelly told reporters that similar schemes in the past have raised money for militant groups like Hamas and Hezbollah.

"This is not the end of our investigation," the attorney general added. "We are following the money. We will work to track it down wherever it went."

According to Kelly, one of the men previously ran a business in the 1990s that was partly bankrolled by the blind sheik; another was a "confidant" of Rashid Baz, the Lebanese immigrant convicted of the 1994 deadly shooting assault on a van full of Hasidic students on the Brooklyn Bridge; and a third lived in the same Brooklyn apartment as the secretary of a key Hamas fundraiser and leader in the 2000s.

Neighbors of the Ramadans in Ocean City, Md., described seeing a dozen or more federal agents and New York Police Department officers show up at the brothers' homes. The investigators brought one man out in handcuffs and also pulled out a safe, put it on the front porch and used tools to break into it.

The neighbors, Charles Mack and Roger Flather, said in phone interviews that one officer turned to them and asked as an aside, "Have you ever seen a million dollars in cash?"

The Ramadans were being held without bail pending extradition to New York. The names of their attorneys were not immediately available.

The total amount of money involved in the scheme remains unclear. But financial records show the traffickers deposited at least \$55 million in proceeds in small banks in and around Ocean City.

The Ramadan brothers sometimes showed up at the banks carrying cash in beer cooler bags, authorities said.

The scheme cost the state an estimated \$80 million in tax revenue.

Shooting of Gay Brooklyn Resident Raises Question of Hate Crime Statute

A man was fatally wounded after being shot in the face early Saturday morning as he walked with a companion in Greenwich Village.

Mark Carson, 32, a Brooklyn resident, was walking through the Village when suspected shooter Elliot Morales approached him and his friend. Police say Morales followed Carson and a companion through the Village, asking if they “want to die here,” Police Commissioner Raymond Kelly said.

Police said Morales then yelled anti-gay slurs before shooting Carson point-blank in the face with a .38 caliber silver revolver, according to the charges. Morales was soon arrested a few blocks away.

“[O]ur city mourns more senseless death caused by gun violence,” said Council Member Jumaane D. Williams (D-Brooklyn), co-chair of the city council’s task force to combat gun violence.

Though Carson was a victim of gun violence, it appears that the crime involved more than the criminal use of a lethal weapon. “This clearly looks to be a hate crime, a bias crime,” Kelly said.

In 2000, the New York State legislature determined that violence based on “bias and prejudice” were on the rise in New York. To combat this trend, the legislature created the Hate Crime statute, which is invoked when a person intentionally commits a criminal act against another based on a belief or perception of race, gender, religion, age, disability, or sexual orientation. The penal law was updated to “provide clear recognition of the gravity of hate crimes and the compelling importance of preventing their recurrence.

“Hate crimes can and do intimidate and disrupt entire communities and vitiate the civility that is essential to healthy democratic processes,” the legislature wrote in the legislative notes accompanying the law.

Carson was viewed by friends as a “a proud gay man. A fabulous gay man.”

Police said this is the 22nd anti-gay attack in the city this year—as compared to 13 such crimes during the same period last year. On May 5th, a gay couple was brutally attacked outside of Madison Square Garden.

“There was a time in New York City when hate crimes were a common occurrence,” said City Council Speaker Christine Quinn in a statement. “There was a time in New York City when two people of the same gender could not walk down

the street arm-in-arm without fear of violence and harassment. We refuse to go back to that time. This kind of shocking and senseless violence, so deeply rooted in hate, has no place in a city whose greatest strength will always be its diversity.”

City Insists There’s No Racial Motivation in Stop-and-Frisk

The federal civil rights challenge to the contentious New York Police Department tactic of stop, question and frisk is winding down after more than nine weeks of testimony from men who say they were wrongly stopped because of their race and police officials who believe the nation’s largest force operates with integrity.

City attorney Heidi Grossman said during summations Monday that there is “no indication of racial motivation whatsoever” in the practice.

U.S. District Court Judge Shira Scheindlin must eventually examine more than 7,000 pages of trial record and may order major changes to the policy, reforms that could have a nationwide impact on how police departments operate.

More than 5 million stops have been made in New York in the past decade, mostly of black and Hispanic men. Police must have reasonable suspicion to stop someone, a standard lower than probable cause needed to justify an arrest. Only about 10 percent result in arrests.

About a dozen black and Hispanic men told the judge of disturbing and uncomfortable encounters with police that left them feeling confused, angry and scared. One witness, 24-year-old Nicholas Peart from Harlem, wept on the stand

as he described how he was handcuffed and put into the back of a squad car. A teenager told how he was stopped walking down the street. In each instance, the witnesses said they could find no basis for the stops other than they were minorities. But many of the officers who did the stopping also explained their legal reasoning.

Lawyers for the men who sued police say officers are making illegal stops in part because they felt pressure from superiors instituting illegal quotas. Some officers testified

said they were punished for not making enough stops and were harassed by fellow officers upset they had blown the whistle. Yet others said no quotas existed and they never felt pressure to make a stop.

The trial has provided a rare window into the NYPD, with about a dozen officials testifying on how they do their jobs. Officers are told to stop the “the right people, at the right time in the right location,” a phrase first heard in the early days of the case on a secret recording made by one whistleblower offi-

cer during a heated exchange over his performance evaluation. Since then, it has been repeated by nearly every official who testified.

“It’s a tool that needs to be used properly, and as borough commanders you should have adequate checks and balances in place, and you should be looking at them with your staff,” said Deputy Chief James Hall, who is in charge of patrol. “There is a focus on when it is used ... right time, right location, you know, right individual.”

Police have said the phrase means the location where crimes have been occurring, at the time they have been occurring, and an individual who matches the description of a crime suspect, or someone who appears about to commit a crime. Lawyers for the men who have sued say, though, that the phrase is code for targeting blacks and Hispanics in poor neighborhoods.

Plaintiffs say a court monitor must be appointed to facilitate changes in training, supervision and the documentation of street stops. An expert for the city testified that the department has already enough checks and balances already in place.

The tactic has become a city flashpoint, with the mayor and police commissioner defending it is a necessary crime-fighting tool, and other city lawmakers calling for major change.

‘Whitey’ Bulger’s Lawyers Seek Name Of FBI Informant

Prosecutors in the trial of reputed gangster James “Whitey” Bulger objected Monday to a request to provide the name of a confidential informant who Bulger’s lawyers hope can help undermine the credibility of two key government witnesses.

Bulger’s lawyers have asked U.S. District Judge Denise Casper to order prosecutors to turn over the name of the informant referenced in an FBI report from 2000. They say the informant gave information about former Bulger associates Kevin Weeks and John Martorano that could contradict their testimony at trial.

In court papers filed Monday, prosecutors said they have agreed to give the defense a copy of the FBI report, but are not required to give the name of the informant, who reported only “street talk.”

Bulger’s lawyers claim the informant said that Weeks and Martorano each had assured certain people that they were cooperating with law enforcement but would not provide prosecutors with incriminating information about those particular individuals. The defense believes that could hurt their credibility when they testify at Bulger’s upcoming trial.
